WEIGHING IN YOUR FISH

Congratulations to Cliff Bailie, the winner of the Top Fish for December (3.405 kg Trevally (score 6.810)) AND January (2.670 kg Kahawai (score 8.010)). Other good fish in December were 5.310 kg Snapper - 1 each to Sheila and Cliff. Fishing should improve in February with fewer boats around to scare the fish off.

Remember that to weigh in your fish, either contact the weighmaster in the first instance, or take it to Millers Meats in Waipu (or another establishment with certified calibrated scales), get a printout of the weight and then contact the weighmaster - Cliff (432 7071) or Larry (021 185 5415).

The problem with the water supply to the Clubhouse has been solved with the installation of a 3000-litre water tank, filter and pump. Thanks to Waipu ITM for giving us a good discount on the purchase of the tank. This will be topped up each time it rains (once we have renewed the spouting), and hopefully there will be no more issues for the foreseeable future.
