OCTOBER MIX AND MINGLE

He also covered boat maintenance and how we boat owners can take care of the simple things - giving your motor a good 5 minute flush after use in salt water, keeping the steering cable cleaned and freshly greased, checking wiring for dry joints, keeping your fuel fresh and filtering out any water that may be sitting in the tank - and much more. These steps can save you time and money on your regular service. A big thanks to Paul and his deputy for giving of their time and sharing their knowledge.

Fish of the Month for September was won by Sheila Jackson with a 6.385 kg Snapper on 25 September. This was good timing for our entry in the Super Club competition held at Kamo Club, where Waipu came in third.
