## FISH OF THE MONTH

Unfortunately, you were told a porky last month, as there was a Fish of the Month for July. This was taken out by Sheila Jackson with a 2.018kg trevally.

Fish of the Month for August was won by Linda Lee who caught a 1.9kg Kahawai on the Waipu River. Cliff reported that there were still not a lot of fish out there, except that he has seen a couple of sharks, an orca and 2 whales, plus hundreds of dolphins.

Remember that the winner of the Fish of the Month collects a prize valued at \$25, but you must be an active member of the club to be eligible.

Note: to weigh in your fish, either contact one of the weighmasters in the first instance, or take it to Millers Meats in Waipu (or another establishment with <u>certified calibrated scales</u>), get a printout of the weight and then contact the weighmaster - either Cliff (432 7071) or Jill (021 108 1603).

Fishing starts at 1300 hrs on Friday  $18^{th}$  and the weigh in is at the clubhouse on Saturday  $19^{th}$  at 1530 hrs. Line fishing either by boat or surfcasting only, and within the area of Bream Head to outside the Hen & Chicks (max 1 km) to Te Arai Point. The winner of the Cup and bragging rights is the club with the 2 heaviest Snapper.

## **COMPARISON CHART**

For scoring fish in monthly competition

Snapper	Weight equals score
Kingfish	Weight equals score
Trevally	2 x weight equals score
Kahawai	2 x weight equals score
Gurnard	4 x weight equals score
Tarakihi	4 x weight equals score
John Dory	4 x weight equals score

#### Example:

Snapper	10kg	= 10
Kingfish	10kg	= 10
Trevally	5kg	= 10
Kahawai	5kg	= 10
Gurnard	2.5kg	= 10
Tarakihi	2.5kg	= 10
John Dory	2.5kg	= 10

In the event of a tie, the winner will be drawn from those who are equal.
