## SUPER CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

## Redrafted February 2018 to clarify rules

- 1. Fishing starts at 4.30am on the confirmed day, weigh in is on the second day.
- 2. The fishing area for this competition is anywhere on the east or west
- 3. Weigh in is to start at 2.30pm and finish at 4.30pm.
- 4. 3 snapper (or 2 fish of another species that the host club determines prior to the event) will be weighed from each participating club.
- 5. The host club has the right to nominate the species to be fished for in that competition. (Billfish and other gamefish are excluded from this competition)
- 6. Once a club has weighed their 3 fish they cannot withdraw a fish to present another.
- 7. All scales must be calibrated and certified, a weigh master or club member should be present while their club's fish are being weighed.
- 8. There must be a minimum of 3 club members representing a club present at the weigh in. (*if one person representing a club turns up with two fish to weigh they will be disqualified*)
- 9. Only clubs that have <u>not hosted the event previously in the current</u> <u>round</u> can put their names into the draw for the following year's hosting rights. There must be a minimum of 3 club members representing a club present to go into the draw. Any club not present will not enter the draw.
- 10. Clubs in the current round are Waipu, Hikurangi, Oakley, Kamo, Pt Curtis, Whangarei, Mangawhai & Tutukaka
- 11. Clubs eligible to enter this competition are all clubs from Wellsford to Cape Reinga
- 12. The entry fee for each club is \$200 which is to be paid to the hosting club, this will go towards costs and prizes for the two winning anglers.
- 13.All anglers must comply with the IGFA and NZSFC fishing rules and angling regulations.
